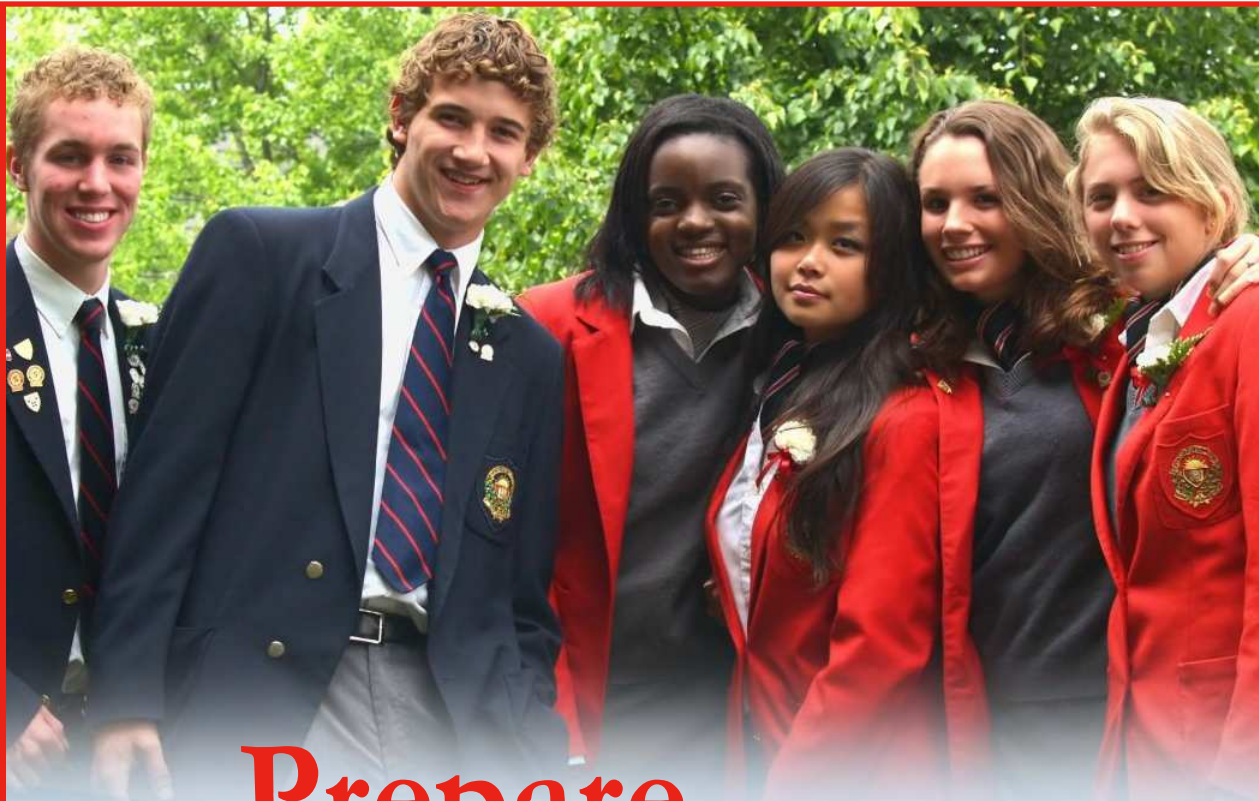

Students who enrol in Stanstead College's Grade 12 program do so for a number of reasons. Some want to explore new options before beginning their post-secondary education. Others want to take advantage of the rigorous academic program to better prepare themselves for college or university. Some use Grade 12 as a means of gaining acceptance to top universities in Canada and around the world.



Whatever their reasons, students who enrol in Grade 12 at Stanstead College are prepared academically and mentally for life after high school. - 7-day-a-week boarding: A maturing experience that fosters self-reliance

- Information technology: The use of laptop computers by on a wireless campus-wide network allows for broad and effective integration of information technology throughout the school
- Comprehensive co-curricular activities, including athletics, the arts, a wide variety of clubs and the opportunity to be involved in community service

## The Class of 2009...

- 37 students received university acceptances
- 2 applied to CEGEP and were accepted
- 3 applied to Ontario colleges and were accepted
- 28 were admitted into their first-choice university/college and program.
- Students received offers from four Ivy League schools: Harvard, Dartmouth, Brown and Cornell. Other offers included Stanford, Colgate, Boston and Bowdoin.
- 24% of the graduating class accepted offers from Ontario
- 28% of the graduating class accepted offers from the USA
- 1 student accepted an offer from UBC
- 6 students accepted offers from Maritime universities
- 5 students accepted offers from Quebec universities
- 1 student accepted an offer from a university in Mexico
- 2 students accepted an offer from a university in the UK
- In all, a total of 63 scholarship offers valued at over \$450,000.
